6 OF THE BEST LUXURY CAMP SITES

1 Lancashire A stay with Larks & Lanterns on their idyllic riverside site in Bleasdale offers five-star luxury under a canvas roof. These three-bedroom tents have wood floors, a log-burning stove, sofa and comfy chairs, a kitchen and a bathroom. Three nights in a tent for six costs from £415, lantermandlarks.co.uk.

2 Wales Inspired by African safaris, camping at Pentre Mawr in Denbighshire means being pampered with kingsize beds, fluffy robes, TV and DVD players and even a hot tub on your private terrace. Each tent sleeps two and costs £200 per weekend night, with a minimum of two nights, hottubsafari.co.uk.

3 North Yorkshire Sleep under the stars at Camp Katur near Bedale, where the Woodland Hide Unidome has a clear roof. Outside there is a BBQ and a firepit so you can grill a feast to eat by candlelight. A weekend break for two costs from £160, campkatur.com.

4 Devon Perched on a hill on the edge of Dartmoor, Longlands Safari Lodges offer the ultimate in relaxation. The lodges sleep six and have luxurious bathrooms and kitchens. Outdoors there's a boating lake and a firepit for toasting marshmallows. A weekend break costs from £595, longlandsdevon.co.uk.

5 Scottish Borders Yurts are the tents used by nomads in Mongolia, but at Ettrick Valley they've been transported to a pretty spot on the Scottish Borders. Furnished with colourful rugs and comfy beds, they're heated by a wood-burning stove. A three-night weekend break for six costs from £360, goglamping.net.

6 Norfolk Situated in a remote location on the coast, Wild Luxury's Serengeti Lodges sleep six in comfort. There's a restaurant or you can buy the catch of the day from the

local fishmonger to cook yourself. A weekend break costs from £495, wildluxury.co.uk. ■
