A NORTH-EAST “glamping” village has reached the finals of a prestigious competition.

Camp Katur, in Bedale, North Yorkshire, is a finalist in the 2015 White Rose Awards.

The site is nominated in the best caravan, holiday park and holiday village category for the second year running.
